

MEN'S ALL STAR SELECTION

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl at least one league in the South Sound USBC jurisdiction.
2. Five members plus one alternate will be selected to the All Star Team. A point system will be used as a guideline for the selection. Points are awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Top 4 averages out of each center
 - b. Top 10 averages in Bowlero Draft Classic. If all 4 high averages at Bowlero come from draft classic (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 4 high averages at Bowlero)
 - c. Top 10 averages in Pacific Draft Classic. If all 4 high averages at Pacific come from draft classic (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 4 high averages at Pacific)
 - d. All finalists at South Sound USBC Masters tournament
 - e. Top 5 scratch all events for South Sound USBC Open association tournament
 - f. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking average out to decimal points.
 - g. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Chairman of the All Star selection committee will be appointed by the South Sound USBC president. Members of the committee may consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
4. Cut off date for averages shall be March 8 and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for selection to both Regular and Senior All Star Teams shall bowl on the Regular All Star Team and the next person on the Senior All Star list will be on the team.
6. Those not selected to the team but who were high average in a bowling center, Masters winner, City All Events Champion or high composite in the city will be recognized as being honorable mention.
7. To be given a separate inclusion in the individual awards, a house league must
 - a. have a sufficient number of high quality scratch bowlers to assure competitiveness for the special awards, and
 - b. apply to the All Star Selection Committee for special awards prior to October 1 of each season. The acceptance of this special award status and the number of points to be awarded shall be the sole discretion of the Committee. If special award status is granted to a house league, the remaining leagues in the house shall vie for the "House Average" awards found in 2c above.

SENIOR MEN'S ALL STAR

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in South Sound USBC.
2. Must be 55 years of age by March 1.
3. Five members plus one alternate will be selected to the All Star Team. A point system will be used as a guideline for the selection. Points are awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Top 8 averages in Tower Senior Scratch Match League, of those 55 and over and no sliding scale. If a bowler leads league in average and is not 55 next highest 55 or over bowler will get 1st place points.
 - b. If all 4 averages come from Tower Senior Scratch no points will be awarded for house average
 - c. Top 4 averages in each house
 - d. Top 8 qualifying round scores in Senior Masters (over 55, regardless of division).
 - e. Top 5 Senior Scratch All Events in South Sound USBC open tournament
 - f. Top 4 South Sound averages for all traveling leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside South Sound USBC as long as at least 6 are within South Sound USBC
 - g. Top 5 Scratch All Events in South Sound USBC Senior T ournament.
 - h. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking the averages out to decimal point.
 - i. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
4. Cut off date for averages will be March 8 and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior member who qualifies for the Regular All Star team will be honored with selection to the Regular All Star Team and the number 7 senior on the list as compiled and chosen by the committee shall be chosen as a Senior All Star
6. Those not selected to the team but who are high average in a house, Masters winner, high Senior scratch all events in South Sound Open Tournament will be recognized as honorable mention
7. To be given a separate inclusion in the individual awards, a house league must
 - a. have a sufficient number of high quality scratch bowlers to assure competitiveness for the special awards; and
 - b. apply to the All Star Selection Committee for special awards prior to October 1 of each season. The acceptance of this special award status and the number of points to be awarded shall be in the sole discretion of the Committee. If special award status is granted to a house league, the remaining leagues in the house shall vie for the "House Average" awards found in paragraph 3a above.

LADIES ALL STAR SELECTION

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in the SSUSBC.
2. Five members plus one alternate will be selected to the All Star Team. The All Star team will be selected based on a point system. Points awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Top 5 Scratch All Events in City Mixed tournament.
 - b. Top 4 averages in each center (Only exception is Narrows. If top 4 averages come from EQC Ladies league no other points will be awarded to Narrows).
 - i. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking average out to decimal points
 - c. All Finalists in South Sound Ladies Classic tournament
 - d. Top 5 scratch all events in SSUSBC Women's Tournament
 - e. Top 4 South Sound averages for all traveling leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside South Sound USBC as long as at least 6 are within South Sound USBC
 - f. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Selection committee chairman will be appointed by SSUSBC President and committee will consist of board and non-board members with an attempt made to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
4. Cut off date for averages will be March 8 and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of the league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for both Regular and Senior All Star teams shall bowl on the regular All Star team.
6. Those not selected to the team but were high average in a center, Classic winner, scratch all events winner, will be recognized as honorable mention

SENIOR LADIES ALL STAR

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in the SSUSBC and must be 55 years old by March 1.
2. Five members plus one alternate will be selected to the All Star Team. The All Star team will be selected based on a point system. Points awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Top 4 averages in each center.
 - b. Top 5 senior scratch all events finishers in South Sound USBC association tournament
 - c. Top 5 all events in SSUSBC Mixed Tournament.
 - d. Top 5 all events in SSUSBC Senior Tournament
 - e. Top 5 finalists in the Senior Division of the SSUSBC Ladies Classic Tournament
 - f. Top 4 South Sound averages for all traveling leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside South Sound USBC as long as at least 6 are within South Sound USBC
 - g. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Selection committee chairman will be appointed by SSUSBC President and committee will consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star Team members.
4. Cut off date for averages will be March 8 and bowlers must have bowled 2/3 of the league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for the Regular All Star team will bowl on the Regular All Star Team and the next in line will be selected to the Senior All Star Team.
6. Those not selected to the team but were high average in a center, Scratch all events winner, Classic winner will be recognized as honorable mention.
