

WASHINGTON STATE 600 CLUB

1. The Tournament is known as the Championship Tournament and shall be held the last weekend in September. The Washington State 600 Bowling Club's Annual Meeting will be held on Saturday night of that weekend.
2. Entries to be mailed out no later than six (6) weeks prior to the tournament. Closing date of entries shall be seven (7) days prior to opening date. Entries postmarked the first business date following the closing date will be accepted.
3. All entrants must have a National 600 Club card (or proof of applying). **Entrants must hold a current USBC card.** An individual without a USBC card, who wishes to participate in the tournament, may do so upon payment of the \$21.00 affiliate membership fee and the Washington State Club dues. 2008-09 Washington State dues are payable with entry, \$3.00 per year. New members to the Washington State 600 Club must pay a one time permanent membership fee of \$1.00.
4. Entrants shall use their highest average of 21 games or more at the end of the previous winter season regardless of whether established as a regular member or substitute from any sanction league. If no winter season average, a summer average shall be used or a current average of 12 games on tournament opening. If no average, entrant must bowl scratch.
5. WIBC Rule 319a AVERAGE-CONDITIONS THAT APPLY will be enforced with the exception that bowler need **not** report their current average if it is ten (10) pins higher than their previous season's average and USBC Rule 319e AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT shall be waived for this tournament.
6. USBC Rule 319a-3 REPORTING INCORRECT AVERAGES, will be enforced that bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower that the correct average thereby resulting a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher that the correct average. However, corrections in average may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series.
7. USBC Rule 319d REPORTING PRIZE WINNINGS will be enforced. All bowlers, **regardless of average must comply with the provision of Rule 319d.**
8. Washington State 600 Club Secretary is tournament Chairperson and has full charge of score sheets and conduct of tournament. All expenses to be paid out of tournament fund except score keeping and printing of entry forms which will be paid out of the general fund. Money made on the 50/50 raffle is also to be used to defray the expenses of the tournament. Balance of expense funds to be paid to the tournament chairperson. Entry fees to be refunded if scores are lost due to malfunctioning of automatic machines if participants are unable to rebowl.
