

South Sound 2007-2008  
**Youth All Star Selection**

- 1 Six young men and six young women will be selected to the South Sound Youth All Star Team. The All Star Selection Committee will be appointed by the youth Committee Chairperson. The South Sound Youth All Star Team will be determined by point system. Minimum average for girls is 165 and boys is 175.
- 2 Youth bowlers must bowl in at least one league in the South Sound USBC jurisdictional area and be a member in good standing of USBC. Youth under 18 years of age as of March 15, 2008 must have the parental permission portion of the All Star Agreement signed to participate in any matches or practices. If consent is not provided the youth will be honored as an all star and the youth with the next highest point total will bowl.
- 3 Youth bowlers must have completed 2/3 of the league sessions in the league as of March 8, 2008. The South Sound Youth Travel League and the High School Varsity Travel League will be considered as house averages and points awarded to their bowlers accordingly.
- 4 All Star Team members will be required to attend a team meeting. Practice sessions will be arranged to best accommodate all team members. Team members agree to participate in the Inter City All Star match, usually the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday and Thursday of May, and the Inter Association All Star Matches, usually the first weekend of June
- 5 Youth coordinators must submit league averages as of March 8, 2008 by March 15, 2008.
- 6 A. House Averages: Points will be awarded to the top 5 averages from each bowling center and the two travel leagues mentioned above. Only one house average shall be used for each bowler, highest point total from house level applied to bowler's all star points.  
 B. Tournament Points:
  - 1) Points will be awarded to the top 5 **South Sound USBC** youth bowlers in the Fall Invitational and Junior Masters
  - 2) Top 5 Scratch All Events scores in the South Sound USBC Youth Association Tournament
  - 3) 5 points awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners from the scratch divisions, boys and girls, of the monthly King of the Hill. One time only
  - 4) 5 points awarded to anyone who qualifies for the 2008 Junior Gold
  - 5) Participation points awarded to those who participate in the Fall Invitational, Junior Masters, South Sound Swiss, South Sound USBC Youth Association Tournament (Scratch Division only) Tacoma Triple Swiss
- 7 Team members will be required to conduct themselves in a manner that would not be considered derogatory to the sport of bowling or acceptable bowling etiquette. **FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY AFFECT YOUR PARTICIPATION IN ANY OR ALL ALL STAR MATCHES**
- 8 Team members may be required to help fund the costs of the All Star Events through fund raising or participation fees. Efforts will be made to keep the team members financial responsibility to a minimum.
