### SOUTH SOUND USBC SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

1. This tournament will be conducted in accordance with USBC rules governing local association tournaments, in addition to rules adapted by South Sound USBC (SSUSBC)

The tournament consists of the following events:

Senior Men's Singles (2 divisions. A - 65 and older, B - 50 to 64)

Senior Women's Singles (2 divisions. A - 65 and older, B - 50 to 64)

Senior Men's Doubles

Senior Women's Doubles

2. Eligibility: All entrants must be a member of USBC and SSUSBC or one of the reciprocals Westsound, Snohomish County USBC or Thurston County. A non-member living in the SSUSBC jurisdictional area and who does not have a USBC card may purchase a membership card for \$27.00. Bowlers must be at least 50 years of age or older as of January 1, 2026.

Multiple participation allowed: Bowlers may participate in each event as many times as they wish. USBC

Rule 315 regarding multiple participation will apply.

Entry deadline: Completed entries without payment will be accepted and held until the Friday before the reservation date. Telephone reservations will NOT be accepted. Payment in full must accompany entry form to confirm a reservation. Entries for each squad close 30 minutes prior to each squad time as lanes permit.

Entering Average: This is a handicap tournament. Handicap is 100% of 230. Entrants will use averages in

the following order:

Highest USBC certified final average of 21 games or more 2024-25. Unless your current average is 10 pins higher for 21 games as of Jan. 1, 2026, then you must use current average. (USBC Rule 319a Item 2) Highest summer league average for at least 21 games as of the 2024-25 season If no average, the entrant will use 230 (scratch)

USBC Rule 319a, it is your responsibility to report your correct average or your scores can be disqualified. All bowlers regardless of average must comply with the provision of USBC Rule 319d. Prize winnings from certified and non-certified tournaments, including those using a modified format of American Tenpins (example: 9 pin tap), must be used in the application of this rule. All bowlers must comply with Rule 319e, if during the last 12-month period preceding the tournament you accumulated average for 21tournament games was 15 pins or higher, you must use your accumulated average.

6. Tie Scores: In the event of a tie in any event prize money will be combined and split equally. In the event

of a tie for 1st and 2nd, co-champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be presented.

- 7. Awards: The high male and female handicap All Events score (3 games singles and 3 games doubles) in each of four age classes will receive a paid doubles and singles entry into the 2026 WSUSBC State Senior Tournament. Entries are paid from the expense fund. Age classes are A - 70 and older, B - 65 to 69, C - 60 to 64, D - 55 to 59, E -
- 8. Tardy Players: Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score from the frame then being bowled. No score will be given for frames the player (s) missed, USBC Rule 322a. No absentee or vacancy scores

9. All Events: When an entrant competes more than once in doubles or singles, the first appearance in each event will count towards their all events score.

10. Slow Bowling: The tournament officials shall not allow unreasonable delay in the progress of a game.

Should any bowler or team refuse to proceed with the game after being instructed to do so by a tournament official,

Such game or series shall be declared forfeited, USBC Rule 11. This has no bearing on lane problems.

11. Protest: Any protest affecting the eligibility or playing rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager prior to payment of prizes. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Manager within 24 hours. SSUSBC Tournament Manager & Committee will have the authority to hear and act on all protests relating to the Tournament. USBC Rule 329 and 303.

12. Entry fee: The entry fee per event is \$45.00, \$25.00 Lineage & expenses, \$20.00 prize fund.

13. Prize Money: Rule 308 requires all prize fees collected in an event or division of that event to be returned 100 percent to the participants in that event or division of that event. Prize Ratio is 1 in 5, All Events is 1 in 8.
